Course Title:	<b>Introduction to the MLA Auto Locksmithing Course</b>
Dates and Times of Course(s):	Friday 25 <sup>th</sup> September 10:00-12:00hrs Saturday 26 <sup>th</sup> September 15:00-17:00hrs
Course Duration:	2 hours
Course Tutor:	Ron Wakley
Course Content:	This course provides an introduction to the field of auto locksmithing and gives an overview of what is covered in the 2 day MLA Auto locksmithing Course. It highlights how the number of locks on vehicles is decreasing (e.g. driver door lock only) and also how auto locksmithing is not just about programming keys. It highlights the different types of keys available (Tibbe, standard double sided, laser, card etc) and provides demonstrations of stripping the various locks to produce keys as well as extracting and stripping ignitions. The course will also provide an overview of key programming looking at the types of blanks and transponder chips available

It will cover issues such as wafer layout, decoding and demonstration of picks.
