WHY JOIN THE MASTER LOCKSMITHS ASSOCIATION AS AN ASSOCIATE MEMBER?

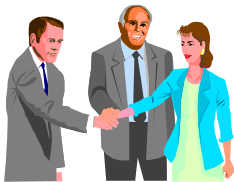
